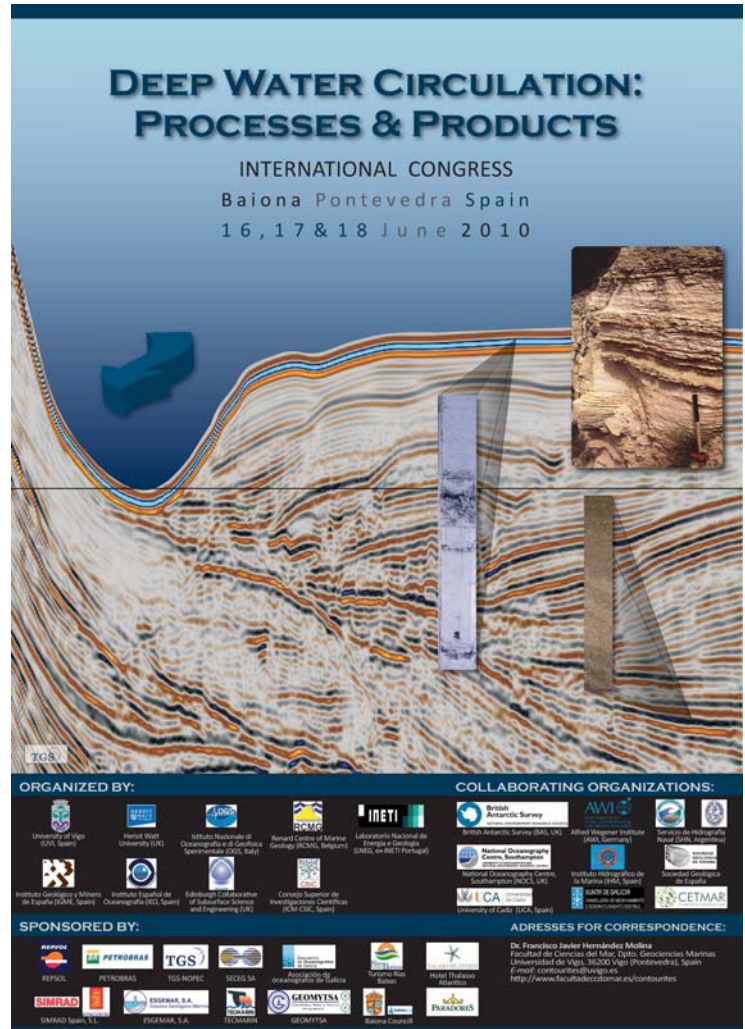
- Geostrophic/thermohaline circulation and bottom currents
